State Party Fellows will work on a variety of projects with each department in our organization (communications, data, field, finance, & operations). The Fellowship is designed to provide general experience within a state party operation. Fellows will get an overview of how State Parties and campaigns work, will get practical experience working in a political organization, and will have opportunities to network with Iowa Democratic Party leaders, elected officials, and key activists. Opportunities for advancement in a specialized department exist.

The IDP State Party Fellowship is a competitive position. We will be accepting 2 State Party Fellows for the April-June program.

IDP Fellows will work a regular part-time schedule (up to 15 hours per week) and will receive a stipend of \$750 per month.
