- Collaborate with the organizing, data and political teams to implement specific state digital organizing objectives and monitor progress towards goals;
- Monitor metrics of success for state-based digital organizing program;
- Other duties as assigned.

- At least 2 cycles of experience managing a digital program on a political campaign or progressive organization;
- Strong understanding of digital organizing program and digital organizing tools;
- Experience with managing volunteers and volunteer leadership development;
- Able to communicate effectively to a diverse set of constituencies;

- Able to work in a fast-paced environment and meet tight timelines;
- Team player with strong interpersonal skills and sound judgment.
